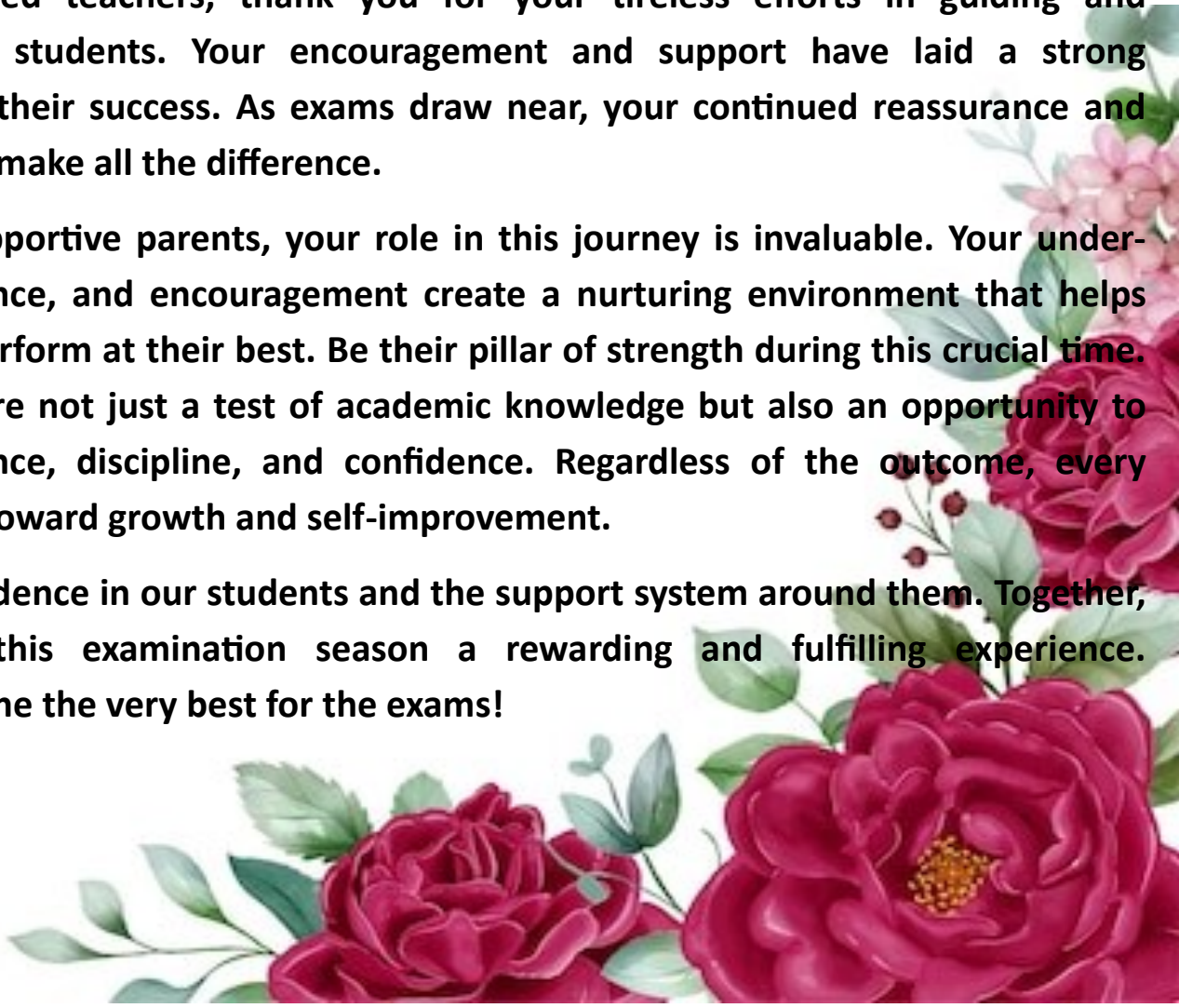

Teachers' Outing to Hornbill Festival



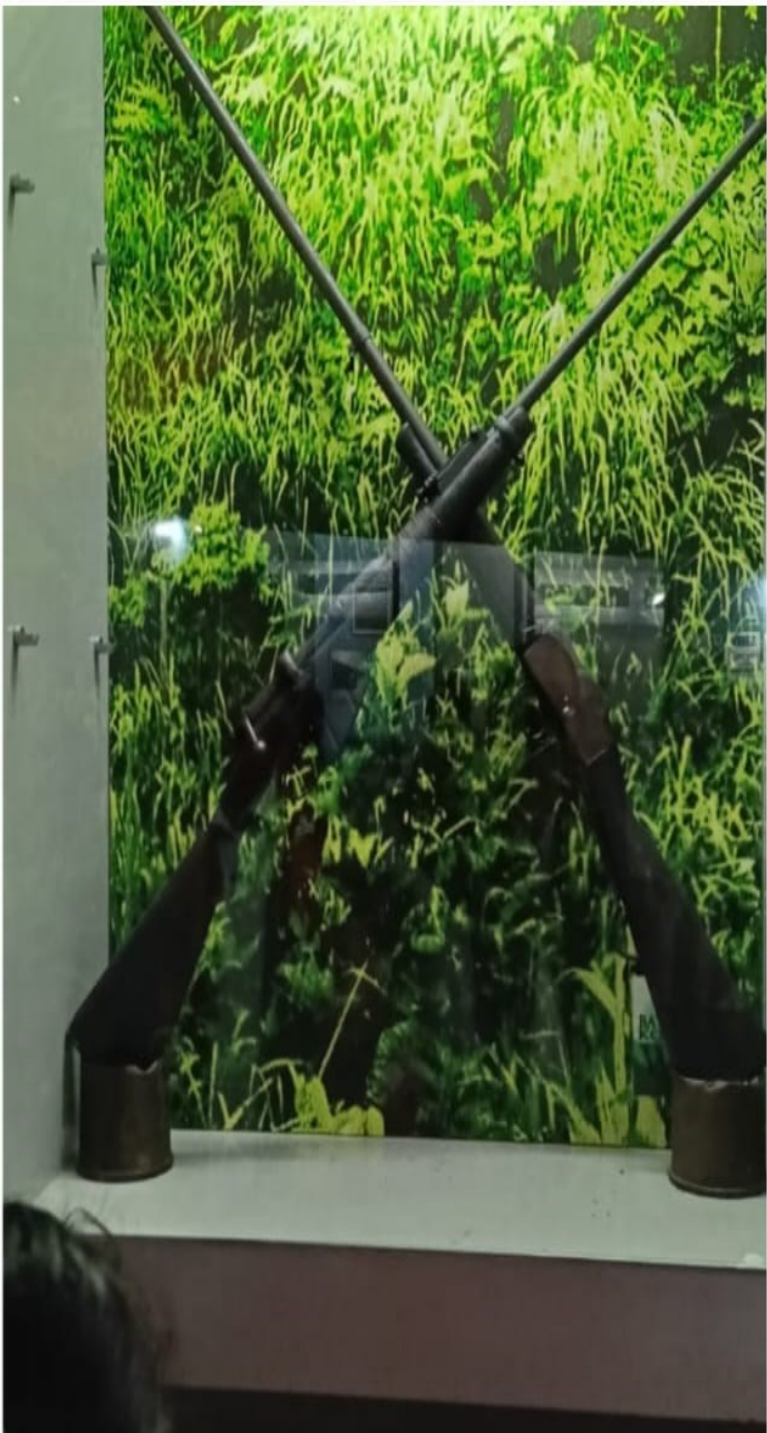
